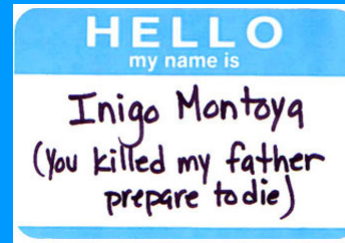

 - They have nametags, it makes things easier 😊

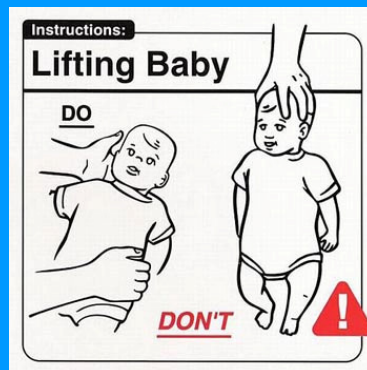


One way to help remember names..

Be Careful of What you Say

- Use politically correct language around participants

Be Aware of Participants Emotions
