Tailgate

- We know how busy tailgate areas can be; this means:
 - Watch participants extremely closely while walking to tailgate
 - Take head counts whenever the group stops
 - It's better to notice someone missing minutes after it happens then after we've crossed completely across campus

 - Monitor area around you for others that could be caught in the crossfire

Football Game

- Depending on what time the game is at and the weather it could be extremely hot
 - Heat Stroke
 - **Symptoms of heatstroke**
 - **The victim's body feels extremely hot when touched.**
 - **Altered mental status (behavior) ranging from slight confusion and disorientation to coma.**
 - **Conscious victims usually become irrational, agitated, or even aggressive and may have seizures.**
- If you notice a participant or member showing these symptoms, notify an exec and proceed to a cooling station

Football Game Continued

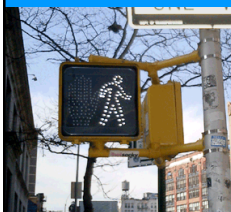
- If a participant wants something to eat or to go to the bathroom you must escort them
 - If your DG partner is already gone with a participant and another participant in your DG needs to go somewhere ask a committee member to escort the other participant so you can remain with your DG
 - Do not get upset with a participant if they need to leave the game at some point, go willingly

Even more Football Game

- If you see a participant leaving without escort and the DG leader or an exec has not noticed, take the initiative to escort them yourself
 - Say something like, “Hey I need to use the restroom too, let’s go together”
 - Try not to say that it’s mandatory for us to go with them
 - This makes them feel like we’re treating them like little kids and then they try to get sneaky
