Types of Presentations

- Round Table
 - Small group in a library or conference room setting
- Class Presentations
 - Speaking to entire Junior and Senior Classes
- Individual Class Presentation
 - Speaking to a specific class (i.e. english)
- Table at Lunch
 - Just a Q and A set up

- Introduction use Aggie Intro it lightens the mood and grabs their attention
- Arrive early to get prepared
- Give Personal experiences
 - Traditions
 - Academics
- Be friendly and open to questions

Pointers (Do's)

- Look over all of your info to prepare for questions and so you know where specific information
- Practice Presentation

How to make an Appointment

- 1st have some dates in mind before you call the school.
- There is a Dialogue to help as well in the manual
- Give name and what group you are with and stress that this a group of student recruiters .
- Express reason for calling (recruiting presentation)
- Once you have gotten permission; ask what type of presentation would they prefer?
- collect all information needed on the Appointment Document list

How to make an Appointment!

- Also ask about the availability of equipment (computer with projector for power point)
- Provide the Counselor with you contact information as well as ARC's contact information which is in the manual./

Appointments

- Try to schedule the appointments before January 15, 2009 since that is the due date for the applications.
- It is preferred to have to appointments set up before they go to winter break because a lot of schools are having finals right after their break.
